Dear Brian Hugick,

The two bulbs of variety 'Crystal Fire' that you provided for inspection were firm with basal area intact and with a good root system. The two bulbs yielded 8 cloves which were peeled and inspected and found to be of good color with no fungal rots, mites or blemishes present.

Bloat nematode was **not** detected in cloves subjected to 'piepan' extraction technique followed by microscopic examination.
