The three bulbs of variety 'German White' that you provided for inspection were firm with basal area intact and with a good root system. The three bulbs yielded 11 cloves which were peeled and inspected and found to be of good color with no fungal rots, mites or blemishes present.

Bloat nematode was **not** detected in cloves subjected to 'piepan' extraction technique followed by microscopic examination.
